1.1. This invitation for Bids is open to all manufacturers/ Authorised dealer / Autho. Agent who have executed works of similar nature i.e. he should have manufactured and sold atleast two no.s of such machines in last three years and in satisfactory operation till date. Performance certificates from clients must be attached to the tender.

1.2. The bidder must have the financial capability. Average annual turn over for similar work during last 3 years shall be submitted.

1.3. The audited balance sheets for the last three years should be submitted and must demonstrate the Soundness of the bidder's financial position. Showing long-term profitability. Where necessary, the Employer will make enquiry with the bidder's bankers.

1.4. The bidder should provide accurate information on any litigation history or arbitration resulting from contracts completed or under execution by him over the last ten years. This should also include such cases, which are in process/progress. A Consistent history of awards against the Bidder of any partner of a joint venture may result in failure of the bid. In case the bidder has not Provided such information and has come to the notice of the Authority, the tender will be rejected at whatsoever stage and in such case all the losses that will arise out of this issue will be recovered from the tender/ contractor and he will not have any defense for the same.

## 2.2 **MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF MACHINERY**

- The contractor shall have to maintain logbooks & shift register, Attendance register of the staff. Contractor has to get work certificate from the concerned dept./ officer of MCC where/ under whom machine/s put in use in the machine Log diary & copy of same must be enclosed it..
- For operating contract payment will be made only for those shifts/ working for which work has been carried out by contractor on the basis of per shift/ 8 hours / two shifts rate quoted in tender.
- For comprehensive maintenance contract penalty will be imposed on the contract for delay work & of road period of the machine if it is delayed beyond reasonable time as mentioned below;
- All minor repairing & preventive maintenance shall be carried out within 24 Hrs. otherwise Rs. 1,000/ per day penalty will be imposed over & above the O & M charges of delay period which will be deducted from the monthly bill of the contractor.
- All major repairing shall be carried out within 7 days otherwise Rs. 2,000/- penalty will be imposed per day, Over & above the O & M charges of delay period which will be deducted from the monthly

### 2.2.1 **SCOPE OF WORK:**

- ❖ During the operation the necessary traffic diversion should be made without causing any inconvenience for the free flow of the other vehicles(if any).
- ❖ Cleaning has to be done as per the schedule adopted by MCC ...
- ❖ Machine should operate based on the single shift of 8 hours.

- ❖ The equipment should be available for operation on all 7 days of a week including Sunday and other holidays.

### **2.2.2. MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION**

- ❖ Maintenance & operational work will be for Five years on contract basis.
- ❖ Operator and helper including, Technical support of technician requirement have to be taken care.
- ❖ Routine Maintenance and servicing, of Machine parts of the vehicle has to be taken care.
- ❖ Payment for the labours has to be according to the labours act,
- ❖ Vehicle insurance, Vehicle registration and employee insurance has to be taken care by the bidder.
- ❖ Replacement of any damaged parts or used parts should be replaced by the agency imminently without affecting the daily work.
- ❖ All Consumables such as Lubricants, Engine oil, Diesel etc., shall be provided by the bidder.
- ❖ Running and major repairs of Machine including replacement of Batteries, Tyres etc. is the responsibility of the agency.
- ❖ Parking place will be provided by MCC.

- ❖ The agency has to make his own arrangement for the security of the machine.
- ❖ While handing over the machinery after five years of maintenance & operation period. Foot path cleaning machine should be in operational condition & the agency should provide additional warrantee for another one year after handing over of machinery.

### **2.2.3 DEMONSTRATION OF THE MACHINERY:**

After opening of the tender documents date and time will be intimated by the MCC for the demonstration of the Specified- Foot path cleaning machine to the bidders. The bidders should demonstrate the machine on the date, time & place mentioned.

## **SECTION –III**

### **3.0 INSTRUCTION TO TENDERES**

- 3.1 Tenderer during the submission of the Tender document has to produce/submit Rs 20,000.00 for Supply of Machine and Maintenance & operation work ,as Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) in the form of DD drawn in favour of the Commissioner MCC from any Nationalized bank payable at Mysore No interest shall be paid on EMD.
- 3.2 Conditional tenders or tenders with alterations in the tender documents are liable to be rejected. Modifications or alterations in the conditions shall not be valid or binding on the department unless they have been specifically and individually accepted

- 3.3 The rates quoted by the Tenderer shall be for the Supply of Foot path cleaning machine and for Maintenance & operation of the machine as noted in the schedule and specifications will hold good till the completion of supply and contract period. They shall be inclusive of all taxes local or general, royalty etc. payable to Government or local bodies in the regions.
- 3.4 The rates in the schedule of prices for supply of Foot path cleaning machine and for Maintenance and operation should be entered both in words and figures in both the copies in indelible ink only and all corrections should be dated and attested. If there is any discrepancy in the rates quoted either in words and or in figures in the two copies for any item the lowest will be taken into account.
- 3.5 The Tenderer is deemed to have acquainted himself fully with the, specifications for the supply and the time allowed for supply of the machine, and for the Maintenance & operation.
- 3.6 The successful Tenderer before entering into agreement shall furnish a performance security in the form of an Unconditional Bank Guarantee in the standard form as given in Annexure – A for an amount equivalent of 10% (ten percent) of the tendered cost.
- 3.7 Further particulars in connection with the supply of machinery and for Maintenance and operation can be had from the office of the Health Officer Mysore City Corporation, Mysore during office hours.
- 3.8 The MCC reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.

- 3.9 In case of any dispute the decision of the Commissioner, MCC shall be final and binding.
- 3.10 Tenderer should sign on each and every page of this Tender schedule in acceptance of all the terms and conditions.
- 3.11 The successful tenderer should supply (operation and maintenance) manual, spare parts manual/C. D's pertaining to the machine at free of cost. Necessary training should be provided by the tenderer.
- 3.12 The successful tenderer on whom the supply order is placed shall intimate to MCC at every stage of work, for inspection.

**3.13 TERMS OF PAYMENT**

- A) Payment will be made after the supply of the machinery and after successful trial round.
- B) Maintenance & operation payment method will be finalized after discussion with the respective company who gets the work.
- C) No advance will be paid for the supply of machinery and for maintenance & operational work.

**4.0 TENDER DOCUMENT**

- 4.1 The Tenderer is required to quote for the supply of machinery and for the Maintenance & operation as per tender documents.
- 4.2 The rate / costs of the work shall be reasonable and not unbalanced. The MCC Health Officer comes across any unbalanced rates/costs; he may require the Tenderer to furnish detailed analysis to justify the same. If after this examination, the Health Officer still feels the rates / cost to be unbalanced he may ask the Tenderer for additional security Deposit or other

safeguards to protect MCC interest against financial loss. Should the Tenderer fails to comply with this, his tender shall be liable to be rejected and may award the contract to any other Tenderer.

- 4.3 The tender shall remain valid and open for acceptance for a period of 90 days (Ninety days) from the date of opening of tender.

## **5.0 SUBMISSION OF TENDER**

- 5.1 The Tenderers shall seal the original and each copy of the tender in separate inner envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as “original” and “Copy”. He shall then place all the inner envelopes in an outer envelope.

The inner and outer envelopes shall be addressed to the Health Officer, Mysore city corporation, Mysore. & should submit their filled tender documents super scribing the name of the work on the face of the cover and marking them as **Tender for Supply of Foot path cleaning machine & Maintenance and operation of machinery for period of five years including necessary fuel, men and consumable etc. along with training of the client in operation & maintenance of the machine** shall be deposited in the tender box kept in the chamber of the Health Officer, MCC. The inner envelopes shall also indicate the name and address of the tenderer. If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as required, the purchaser will assume no responsibility for the tender's misplacement or premature opening. Telex, cable or facsimile tenders will be rejected.

- 5.2 **Tenderer shall essentially comprise the following.**

### **5.2.1 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

Rs 20,000 amount quoted by the bidder as earnest money deposit (EMD) in the form of Demand Draft from any Nationalized bank in favour of the Commissioner MCC payable at Mysore.

**5.2.2 Company Profile**

The applicant should submit adequate data and supporting documents wherever applicable in support of the organization as detailed in 'Annexure-C'. The following aspects should be submitted.

- a) Details of the Firm's registration such as whether an Indian incorporate/Registered under Company's Act, 1956 etc.,
- b) Normal field and area of operation.

**5.2.3 Experience of supply of similar type of Machinery and Maintenance & operation in past**

- a) Details of the Clients and Maintenance of similar type of Machinery in past or in operation.
- b) Supply of any machinery earlier to the time limit specified and any awards for the same. Similarly or the late supply of the machinery for which any penalties imposed.

**5.2.4 Litigation History**

Applicant should provide accurate information on any history litigation to supply of machinery and Maintenance & operation resulting from executed in the last five years or currently under execution shall be furnished in the format as given in Annexure 'D'

**5.2.5 Staff deployment details**

Applicant should provide the list of staff to be deployed in the Maintenance & operation period and their designation number of years of experience in the projects of similar nature and number of years with the firm.

**5.2.7 Indemnification**

The Tenderer shall indemnify the Employer as given in Annexure- 'E' against all losses and claims in respect of

- a) Death of or injury to any person, or
- b) Loss of or damage to Machinery.

Which may arise out any consequence of the execution and completion of the works and the remedying, of any defects therein, and against all claims, proceedings, damages, costs, charges and expensed whatsoever in respect thereof or in relation there to.

**5.2.8 Tenderer prices comprise the following:**

- a) The rate for supply of Foot path cleaning machine and Maintenance & operation, for the contract of five years which is lump sum amount attached by the successful Tenderer complying with the terms and conditions of tender document and shall be for the supply of the machinery and maintenance & operation as prescribed.
- b) The tender prepared by the Tenderer, all correspondence and document relating to the tender exchanged by the Tenderer and the employer, supporting documents and printed literature shall be written in English language only.
- c) All documents issued for the purpose of tendering as described shall be deemed to have been incorporated in the tender for the work.
- d) All duties, taxes, fees and other levies (present and future) payable by the supplier under the contract, or for any other cause, as on the date thirty days prior to the closing date for submission of tenders, shall be included in the total price submitted by the Tenderer.

**5.2.9 Variations of deviations in tender documents:**

The Tenderer shall submit his offer, which shall comply fully with the basic requirements of the tender documents s Specifications and Maintenance & operation terms and conditions of the tender. All Tenderers are cautioned that no conditional offers, variations of deviations by the Tenderers in respect of any item included in the tender shall be entertained or considered.

Furthermore, any deviation from contract conditions, particular specification, or other requirements stipulated in these tender documents other than those specially clarified/amended shall be liable to be rejected as non-responsive.

**5.2.10 Amendment to the tender document**

- a) At any time prior to the stipulated time for submission of tenders, the Health Officer MCC may, for any reason, whether at his own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Tenderer modify the tender documents by issuing an addendum. All addendum thus issued shall also form part and parcel of the tender document not shall be communicated in writing or by fax to all purchasers of the tender documents. Prospective Tenderers shall acknowledge the receipt of the same by writing or by fax to the Health Officer.
- b) To afford prospective Tenderers, reasonable time to take into account an addendum, if any, in preparing their tenders, the Health Officer MCC shall suitably extend the stipulated time for submission of the tenders, as considered reasonable by him.

**5.2.11 Process to be confidential**

- A] The information relating to the examination, clarification evaluation and comparison of tenders / recommendations shall not be disclosed to Tenderers or other persons not officially concerned with such process.
- B] Any effort by the Tenderer to influence the Official in the process of examination, clarification and evaluation may result in rejection of Tender.
