"TWO-STAGE TENDER SYSTEM" TURN KEY BASIS

Tenders are invited by the Superintending Engineer, MCC, Mysore from reputed contractors/firms under **"Two-Stage Tender System" on Turn Key Basis**, **"For establishing an Incinerator of capacity 350 kgs/hr for disposal of animal carcass in Mysore City Corporation"** as per Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rule 2000 and Act 1999, and Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements (Amendment) Rules, 2003.

- i. The tender consists of two stages. **First stage tender** consists of a technical tender only, without reference to the rates and prices for establishing an incinerator of capacity 350kg/hr for disposal of animal carcass.
- ii. Those tenderers who have submitted a technically responsive and acceptable first stage tender will be invited to submit Second Stage Tender.
- iii. **The second stage tender** consists of final technical proposal and priced tender.

Eligibility criteria for Second Stage Tenders:

- i. Joint venture/consortium is not permissible.
- ii. In the last five years period financial turnover in any two financial years shall be not less than the tender amount.
- iii. The bidder should have satisfactorily completed one similar work to an extent of 50% of the cost of the work.
- iv. The assessed available tender capacity shall more than the total tender value.
- v. Non-transferable bid documents can be procured from the Office of The Superintending Engineer, MCC, Mysore on payment of **Rs.10,000/-** in the form of Challan/DD in favour of the Commissioner, MCC, Mysore along with requisition. Additional amount of Rs.1000/- may be added if Tender documents are to be sent by post/Courier. MCC shall not be responsible for late receipt / Non receipt of the documents sent by post/Courier.
- vi. All second stage tenders must accompany an **EMD of Rs. 2.00 lakhs** in the form of DD in favour of Commissioner, MCC, Mysore.
