Short Term Tender Notification

Mysore City Corporation has taken up remodeling of Primary and Secondary Storm water Drains in Mysore City, under **JnNURM**.

Sealed item rate Tenders are invited by the Superintending Engineer, MCC, Mysore from registered **KPWD/CPWD** contractors/ reputed firms under ‘**two cover bid system**’ as per Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurement Rule 2000 and Act 1999 and as per Standard Bid Document – (**KW4**) in the prescribed form in duplicate for work of **Remodeling of Primary and Secondary Storm water Drains, culverts/Bridges, formation of service/approach roads and its appurtenant works etc., which is spread out at different locations in Bannimantap Catchment Area and Hebbal Catchment Area**. The works are envisaged in the entire catchment are grouped into following packages and are as mentioned below.

4.0 SCOPE OF WORK

De-silting of drains, Drain widening, Deepening, Construction of new RCC/Masonry Drain Walls, Rehabilitation of Drain Walls/Culverts, providing concrete bed protection, construction of water recharging structures, utility shifting, Pipe support bridges, lake inlet outlet weir improvements works, improvements to tertiary drains joining Primary/secondary & in low lying areas, dismantling of drain structures, fencing, construction of RCC Bridges/Culverts, which includes, construction of RCC super structure, RCC piers, Pile foundations, RCC/masonry retaining walls, crash barriers, POT – PTFE bearings, construction of approaches, formation of embankments, service/approach roads, junction improvement works, signage, road marking, painting etc.,

Offers are invited on item rate basis, based on MCC design and drawings, as prepared by the consultants.

5.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

5.1 Class I-A/Class – I contactors, individual firms, partnership firms, company, (registered with Karnataka PWD, CPWD) having suitable technical, financial and managerial capabilities satisfying the following conditions are eligible to apply.

- i. Joint venture/Consortia, is not permissible.

- ii. Experience in construction of Storm Water drains, major Canals, remodeling of canals, construction of RCC/Masonry retaining walls, water retaining structures is essential.
- iii. Experience in construction of culverts/bridges on fast track projects. (viz using pre cast construction technology etc.,) and establish proof for the same.

Each Tenderer should further demonstrate:

- i. The Tenderer shall indicate the availability, by owning at least 50% of the key and critical equipment and remaining 50% on hire/lease basis required for the proposed work.
- ii. The Tenderer shall have liquid assets and/or availability of credit facilities/credit lines/letter of credit/certificates from banks for meeting the fund requirement etc and letter of the same shall be enclosed.
- iii. Having similar experience and sufficient manpower resources with similar exposure (experience in storm water drain construction & supervision works) to meet the qualifying criteria.

5.2 TECHNICAL CRITERIA

Should have minimum 3 years experience in construction of similar works such as bridges/culverts, RCC/Masonry drain wall/RCC retaining walls etc in water condition, Service road formation etc as per MORT & H/IRC specification with experience in piling works. In order to qualify in participating in the Tender the Tenderer should have:

- i. Completed RCC bridges of minimum span 10m and length of 30m during the last 3 years and open to traffic & in service for at least 1 year.
- ii. The Tenderer should have executed in any one-year minimum of 80% of the quantities of work as mentioned in the Tender document.

5.3 FINANCIAL CRITERIA.

The applicant should fulfill the following criteria for pre-qualification for each of the packages.

- i. The Tenderer should have achieved in at least two financial years, a minimum financial turnover of not less than two times the estimated cost of the work in the last five years period. Certificate to the effect shall be furnished duly certified by Chartered Accountant.
- ii. The Tenderer should have satisfactorily completed as a prime contractor at least one similar work to an extent of 80% of the cost of the work in the last five years period.
- iii. The assessed available Tender capacity shall not be less than the amount put to Tender.
- iv. The intending Tenderer shall have a Banker's Solvency of a minimum value of 50% of the amount put to Tender for the present financial year .The solvency certificate issued by the bank shall be specifically issued for this project and also duly addressed to "The Commissioner, MCC, Mysore". Original certificate to be submitted.
- v. The intending Tenderer should produce the latest Income tax clearance certificate or a certificate from chartered accountant certifying that there are no Income Tax

- dues and the same has to be notarized by the notary public & submitted along with the application.
- vi. The bid documents, consists of pre-qualification documents – (Volume I), Conditions of Contract, Technical Specifications and Drawings (Volume II) **Bill of Quantities** and the tender in the format indicated in Section-4 of Tender Document (Volume III).
 - vii. Documents shall be submitted in 2 covers. **Cover-1** Containing Volume I & II along with prescribed **EMD** and **Cover-2** shall contain only the **Financial Bid** i.e. Volume-III. Procedure and details of submissions are furnished in the Tender documents.
 - viii. Based on an assessment of the information furnished in the pre-qualification document, those who satisfy the eligibility criteria will be pre-qualified and cover-2 containing their financial bids will be considered for opening and evaluation.
 - ix. **EMD** shall be in the in the favor of **The Commissioner, MCC, Mysore** and may be in the form of Banker's cheque/Demand Draft/Pay Order in favour The Commissioner, MCC, Mysore payable at Mysore or Cash or specified small savings instruments pledged to The Commissioner, MCC, Mysore. Instruments having fixed validity issued as EMD for the tender shall be valid for 45 days beyond the validity of the tender. Conditional Tender & Tenders without EMD in requisite form will be summarily rejected as non-responsive.
 - x. The Tenderer may get all the clarifications required for quoting the Tender in the pre bid meeting.
 - xi. Non-transferable bid documents may be purchased from the office of the Superintending Engineer, Sayyaji Rao Road, Mysore-02 on payment of a non refundable amount of **Rs.50,000** payable in the form of Challan for having credited the money into the **MCC account** (SBM Corporation Branch) along with requisition. Additional amount of Rs.1000 may be added if Tender documents are to be sent by post/Courier. MCC shall not be responsible for late receipt / Non receipt of the documents sent by post/Courier.
 - xii. MCC reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications with out thereby incurring any liability or obligations to inform the applicants of the reasons for such actions.
